(ex-General) Brown just returned from Chicago where he attended a conference on the parade, and he had a lot of work to be done immediately. He conferred with the Commanding Generals of the 5th Division and 6th Service Command, General Vaughn (President Truman's aide), Mayor Kelly, and various other War Department officials. Truman is bringing Eisenhower, Spaatz, Lutes, and the Sec. of War along with him.

The parade is to be on Michigan Ave. and will also include a number of tanks (which will no doubt tear the streets up) and planes—100 B-25's, B-26's and B-29s – which will fly low.

It has been very cool today. I hope it warms up. It was beautiful all week.
