The C-9A, a specially designed version of the McDonnell Douglas DC-9, is equipped as a flying hospital ward. Special features include patient loading ramp, nurse's station, special care compartment, medical service area, and outlets providing therapeutic oxygen, suction, and electrical power to operate hospital equipment (iron lungs, etc.). The USAF is currently operating these fast, smooth-flying jets in the United States, Europe, and the Pacific.
