

IT'S NOT LEGAL IT'S POLITICAL!

Our movement has developed as a challenge to the power of the American establishment. We have emerged as a political response to the social realities that this system has created: a response to its racism, to its wars, to its wage exploitation and dehumanization of people at their jobs, and to its brutal repression of the human beings who challenge the control it exercises on humanity.

The government has begun to use and create laws to punish us for political actions. We must meet this challenge politically; fighting not only the power, but all the means it uses to maintain itself.

Hundreds of our most committed brothers, from pacifist reformers like Dr. Spock to revolutionaries like Bobby Seale, are under indictment, each facing expensive and enervating trials, and with the likely prospect of spending years as half-men in cages.

The intention is to destroy the the movement for serious social change through these means. We must respond. The Oakland Seven were just acquitted by a conservative, middle class jury, who responded when they understood the real issues and motives. There is both hope and a key to our future directions in this acquittal.

The Teach-In will explore three vital questions facing us all: How can we unite together for political defense? How can we explain the issues to the American people? How can we best continue our movement for social change while under attack?
